

## **Bicester & North Oxford CC Junior Club Rules**

Bicester & North Oxford CC is fully committed to safeguarding and promoting the wellbeing of all its members. It is important for junior members to show respect at all times and to share any concerns or complaints that they may have with their age group manager or Helen Plumbe (Club welfare officer).

As a member of Bicester & North Oxford CC you are expected to abide by the following junior club rules:

- All members must play within the rules and respect officials and their decisions without questioning.
- All members must respect opponents.
- Members should keep to agreed timings for training and competitions or inform their coach or team manager if they are going to be late.
- Members must wear suitable kit for training and match sessions, as agreed with the coach/team manager.
- Members must pay any fees for training or events promptly.
- Junior members must remember they represent the club when playing away matches and should ensure their behaviour is beyond reproach.
- Junior members are not allowed to smoke, or consume alcohol of any kind on the club premises or whilst representing the club.

Any breach of club rules will be taken seriously and dealt with in an appropriate manner, which may result in your expulsion from the club.

- All junior members agree to take part in cricket activities in order to learn to play the game, whilst having fun and meeting new/maintaining current friends.
